Questions faculty should cover in their presentations to the Technology Oversight Committee.

- 1. Describe the invention/development. What advantages does it have over what has been commercialized? Who else is in the discovery or early development phase of competing technologies?
- 2. Benchmark your technology vs. what is already available in the marketplace. How does it compare?
- 3. What is your personal ambition? Is it to start a company; license the technology to an existing company; or to make the technology available to the world (e.g., for humanitarian benefits)?
- 4. What are the landmarks/decision points you are facing? What is the timeline?
- 5. What is your fund raising status? How can the committee help guide you?
- 6. What business advice are you receiving? What type of advice is still needed?
- 7. What is the status of any applicable patents? Has a Freedom to Operate analysis been performed?
- 8. What challenges are you facing?
- 9. What are your next steps?
